

WHAT TO EXPECT...After your Hemorrhoid Ligation

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- 1) You will experience a pressure or full feeling. You may feel an urge to have a bowel movement. **DO NOT** strain or force yourself. Plan on resting the remainder of the day.
- 2) You may have slight bleeding. **THIS IS NORMAL**. If you have excessive bleeding, please call our office Mon-Thurs 8-5, Fri-8-2 or UPHS Marquette for after hours and weekends and **ASK FOR THE GENERAL SURGEON ON-CALL**. (Phone #'s listed below).
- 3) Sitz baths may be helpful to relieve discomfort and over the counter pain relievers such as Motrin or Tylenol.
- 4) In 5-10 days you may experience slight bleeding when the bands fall off. You may notice a small, black rubber band in your stool or in the toilet bowl. Don't be alarmed.

- 6) *Make sure that you understand all instructions before leaving the surgery area.*
